

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

033/OFF/502/2021

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), NEW ZEALAND AQUAVIT LIMITED (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 77 B Hurlstone Drive WAIWHAKAIHO, NEW PLYMOUTH 4312 and known NEW ZEALAND AQUAVIT, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

Conditions
Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.
No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day.
Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: Any time on any day
Any alcohol sold by remote sale is not delivered to the buyer (or any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day.
The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site: a) The licence holders name, the licence number, and the date on which the licence expires. b) A copy of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
The following steps must be taken to <u>verify that people are over the purchase age</u> : In the case of an <u>order made using an internet site, telephone order, or physical order</u> - the prospective buyer must declare that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where the prospective receiver is involved that the prospective receiver is also 18 years of age or over) (i) once, when the prospective buyer first commences the order process; and (ii) again, immediately before the sale of alcohol is completed.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on:
